This flight highlights the grapes that made Germany renowned for excellent wine. Begin with a classic Gewürztraminer—intense fruit with a balanced minerality—and then journey through the variations of Riesling, each boasting grapes that hung to the vine a big longer than the last. The glass-corked Spatlese is amazing!

These wines each a story to share. Mirassou is the oldest vineyard in the nation, King Estates uses organic and sustainable farming, the Albarino is the most expensive grape grown in Spain (the wine of the nobles), and La Crema is the 2009 Winery of the Year featuring a 90-point rated Chardonnay.

Can't decide if you are in the mood for whites or reds? This is your flight. Enjoy the supple pear and citrus flavors of the Pinot Blanc, and the grassy herbaceous notes of the Sauv Blanc. Next move to the rare Blue Franc—prominent fruit and zippy tannins—leaving you to finish with a Cabernet Franc. Typically a blending wine, we are featuring it in its true form—lots of fruit, medium tannins and a long, lingering finish.
